We're Going to the Farm

Progression

Outcomes:

Little Foxes

Physical Literacy:

Run, skip, jump, dodge

Equipment:

Scarves or something similar

Activity

- Give each of the children a scarf and tell them this will be their tail tuck slightly into their trousers or into their pocket etc.
- The adults are the 'Big' foxes and the children are the little foxes.
- The big foxes are going to collect the little foxes tails
- The little foxes must run away from the big foxes.
- Once their tails have gone they must sit somewhere out of the way (Choose where this space is)
- If you are doing it in a small group you can be the big fox and the children small foxes and the children who's tails have been caught can help you catch the others

EYFS: Moving confidently in different spaces, creating friendships with others.

Tips: Children may need support to get the tail fixed to their trousers, encourage them to do it themselves. By using a scarf too.

Tips

- If you do not have a large space for this game, we recommend you only do it in small groups. To save any bumps etc.
- You need adult support for this activity.
- This is a high energy activity, children are likely to become hyper and tired after this game.
